PALO VERDE NATIONAL PARK

Palo Verde National Park is located on the Pacific slopes of north-western Costa Rica. The visit will consist of a boat ride through the dramatic mangroves, swamps, swamp forests, saltwater and freshwater lagoons, marshes, and both deciduous and evergreen forests, where the characteristic Palo Verde or Horse Bean grows. Birds are the biggest attraction at Palo Verde National Park; in the wet season the floodwaters of the Tempisque River spread to form extensive marshes that welcome migrant birds from North and South America.

CARTAGENA CANOPY TOUR

Class III & IV

If you are prepared for a huge adventure, you are surely ready for this. The Tenorio River will test your courage with its rapids class III and IV. Irregular and medium waves, complex maneuverings in fast rapids in its class III; intense and powerful but yet predictable in the class IV

Yet, it offers natural treasures including seven national parks, three wildlife reserves that make out of this province “the place” to enjoy of the wild rapids. For those already rafters this trip is a must. Its continued challenges await you as you plunge through twists, turns, and drops down 8 miles of intense challenging rapids. All participants must be in good physical condition. This is a trip of pure magic, unsurpassed beauty, and stunning wildlife scenery that will take your breath away.

ACQUACENTER SCUBA DIVING – COSTA RICA

They invite you to enjoy the world of underwater adventure. Just offshore from Flamingo, the Catalina Islands are considered among the most attractive dive sites in Costa Rica. It is an area where divers often find themselves surrounded by large schools of colorful fish. When you dive the Catalinas, you may experience swimming with abundance of manta rays and stingrays. The formations provide a spectacular variety of marine life from nudibranchs to sharks, with angel fish, jacks, snappers, grunts, octopus, and eels in between. There are several dive spots with depths ranging from 40 ft. to more than 100 ft. Visibility depends upon the levels of plankton and nutrients. It varies from 20 ft. to 100 ft., with an average of 45 ft. approximately. Daily scheduled are morning and afternoon 2-tank boat dives. For the morning trip, the boat leaves the beach of the Flamingo Marina Hotel at 7:45 am, and for the afternoon trip, at 1:30 pm. After a 20-minute ride, you have the opportunity to explore the first underwater site of the day. Afterwards, a surface interval followed by a second great dive, and then back to the hotel. The beach next to our dive center provides an easy access to our boats, Fun Fisher II (37') and Aqualand (40'). Fully equipped with fresh water, radio, oxygen, and emergency equipment, the boats are operated by certified experienced friendly professionals.
